Councilwoman Deb Plahn called the Emergency Meeting to order at 8:30 am followed by the Pledge of Allegiance;


**Motion to approve the agenda – Motioned by Smith 1<sup>st</sup>/Houg 2<sup>nd</sup>. All ayes followed.**

Thode let them know they were able to make the changes with removing cameras and that the cost is now around \$30k and that they city would either have to pay that amount or \$27k to restock everything. Erickson asked about moving the Hall camera to the outside of the building instead of the inside. It was discussed that we would see if they could do that for the same price as what they have quoted already. Plahn asked if they were able to give access to Pipestone County Sheriffs. R. Thode said they are able to for a very small cost. All council members expressed they were happy to hear that.

**Motion to approve installing the cameras by the end of the year and move to camera at the Hall to the outside if able to. Motioned by: Smith 1<sup>st</sup>/Houg 2<sup>nd</sup>.**
